
#### Soil

 A mixture of weathered <u>rock</u>, organic material, <u>water</u>, and air that is capable of supporting life.




## Soil Horizons

 Soil is made up of layers known as horizons.




#### Horizon O

- Top Layer of Soil
- Thin Layer
- Contains loose and partly decayed
  ORGANIC matter



#### Horizon A

- Minerals mixed with Humus.
- Humus- dead <u>organic</u> material.
- Includes <u>roots</u> of plants, burrowing animals & insects.
- Darker soil








#### Horizon B

- The layer of soil
  mostly composed of
  clay and bits of
  weathered rock.
- Roots of trees will stretch to this layer to get <u>water</u>.
- Often called the subsoil.




#### Horizon C

 The layer that contains large unweathered rock.



### Bedrock- Horizon R

Solid, unweathered
 bottom layer of rock.
